

## **Biography Dr. Andreas Beitin**

Andreas Beitin studied Art History, Applied Cultural Studies, and Modern and Contemporary History.

He obtained his doctoral degree in 2004, after which he worked at the ZKM | Museum of Contemporary Art in Karlsruhe. After holding in various academic and curatorial positions, he became director of the museum in 2010.

Since then, Beitin has conceived numerous internationally acclaimed exhibitions as curator or co-curator. He has published scholarly texts in Germany and abroad, given lectures and edited numerous publications. For many years, Beitin has been a member of various art juries and academic committees, and he has received several awards for his curatorial work.

From 2016 to 2019, he was Director of the Ludwig Forum for International Art in Aachen; since April 2019, Andreas Beitin has been Director of the Kunstmuseum Wolfsburg.
